

FREE CERVICAL CANCER VACCINATION CAMP AT BAPTIST CHRISTIAN HOSPITAL, TEZPUR



On 7th August 2025, Baptist Christian Hospital, Tezpur, in collaboration with the Rotary Club of Greater Tezpur and the Rotary Club of Bombay Pier, organized a free cervical cancer vaccination program for young girls. The event aimed to raise awareness and prevent cervical cancer through early vaccination.

A total of 50 young girls age 10-20 years received the HPV vaccine, including daughters and granddaughters of patients who battled with cancer. The event began with an awareness car rally, followed by an awareness talk by Dr. Sumita Gogoi on cervical cancer prevention. The vaccination was administered under her guidance.

The hospital's palliative care team, along with social work interns from Tezpur University, played a key role in facilitating the program. They were instrumental in mobilizing the beneficiaries from nearby communities and ensuring that the vaccines reached those who needed them most.
